Daily Life Noise

How to use your room

Kitchen/Toilet/Bathroom

Do not throw away left over food/cooking oil directly in the drainage. Cooking oils are to be absorbed into paper products and to be disposed with burnable garbage. If you want to install a shower toilet in your bathroom, please contact Sumai Center first. You cannot install a shower toilet by yourself.



If drainage pipe is blocked, you will have to pay for the pipe cleaning.

Condensation

When your window/wall is wet, molds may grow. Please wipe it well. Please open door/window from time to time to let fresh air in.

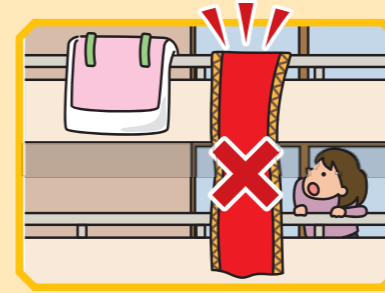


Water leakage

When water pipe is blocked, you will pay not only for the repair but also for compensation due to the damages to the downstairs if any.



BALCONY



When hanging out blanket/laundry, please clip them tightly to avoid accidental falling. Do not hang them out too long over the lower-level balcony.



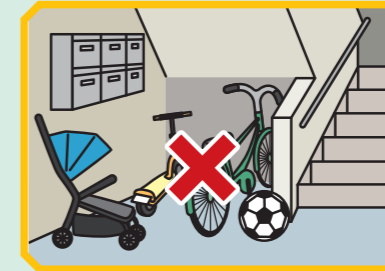
Do not leave things on the balcony. They may interrupt your evacuation when there is an earthquake/fire.



Do not throw trash from the balcony.

COMMON AREAS

Do not leave things on the staircase, corridor or postal area. They might prevent your evacuation when there is an earthquake/fire.

Put in a transparent/semi-transparent plastic bag.

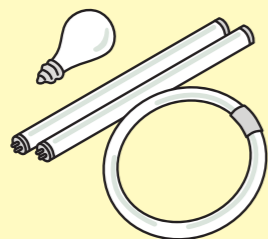


Non-burnable Garbage

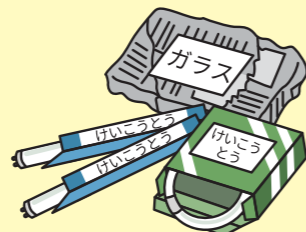

< example >

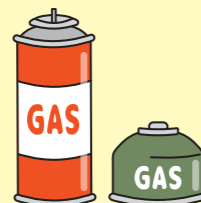
Remaining gas may cause an accident. Empty out all of the gas. Do not make holes.

Gas cylinder

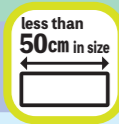
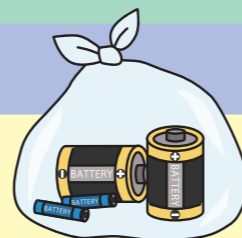


Throw away spray cans only in one transparent/semi-transparent plastic bag.



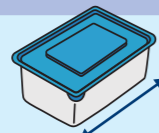
Dry-Cell Batteries

Throw away Dry-Cell Batteries only in one transparent/semi-transparent plastic bag.

Garbage with PURA Mark. Garbage made from plastic only and no longer than 50 cm.



Garbage Days



Throw garbage before 8 o'clock in the morning.

Category	How to throw away	Garbage day
Burnable Garbage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Drain liquid well from kitchen garbage. Put in transparent/semi-transparent plastic bag. 	
Non-burnable Garbage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Put its original package or wrap with paper. Indicate name of item. Eg. Glass / Fluorescent light 	
Spray Cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not make holes. Empty out all of the gas. Only put spray cans in one transparent/semi-transparent plastic bag. Bottle caps should be separated and placed with Plastic Garbage. 	
Dry-Cell Batteries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Put only Dry-Cell Batteries in one transparent/semi-transparent plastic bag. 	
Plastic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All garbage with PURA Mark. Garbage made from plastic only and less than 50 cm in size. Put in transparent/semi-transparent plastic bag. Please clean the garbage if it is dirty. 	
Cans, Bottles, Plastic & PET Bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> PET bottle has mark. Put in transparent/semi-transparent plastic bags. Items containing foods and drinks are included in this category. 	
Small Metal Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No need to put in plastic bags (for very small items such as cutlery, please put in plastic bags). Dangerous items such as knives/scissors must be wrapped with cardboard. Name of item must be indicated. Eg. knife/scissors. Umbrella spokes can be disposed. Umbrella cloth to be thrown as burnable garbage. 	
Used Cloth & Used Paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not throw away when raining. 	
Oversized Garbage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To pay for charges when throwing.
